

# Instructions for School Year Personal History Pages

This unit is designed to be used over the course of a school year, working on it a little bit each month. The templates cover September through May.

You can choose to fill out the cover, general info, family, and family tree pages during the very first month you decide to do this project, or you can spread them out over several months. (For example, if you start schooling in August, fill out the “extra” pages then and begin the September monthly pages in September.

Fill out the holiday pages as you get to that particular holiday during the school year.

Print only the pages you wish to use. If you have multiple children, you might print a few different styles of choice.

Here are the contents of this 150+ page unit:

## **Cover Pages.**

Choose one of the cover pages to fill out for the cover of your binder. You can feel free to create your own if you would rather.

## **General Information Pages**

Choose one of these styles.

## **Family Pages**

Choose one of these styles to fill out. These are three page long templates with prompts having to do with family. The third page can be used for adding pictures or more writing.

## **My Family Tree Pages**

Choose one of these styles to fill out. These are two page long templates. To the second page, you can add more pictures or written descriptions as desired.

## **Monthly Pages**

These start with September and go through May and are multiple pages long. Here is the basic format for each month:

- Page one should be filled out over the course of the month as things happen.
- Page two invites your student to learn a little bit of current events about what is going on locally, nationally and worldwide during this school year.
- Page three is a weather page
- Page four has some random prompts to write about for the month
- Page 5 is a page for pictures
- Page 6 is a blank bordered page for anything else of interest
- The last page of each of the month templates is meant to be used with younger children by itself. This gives younger kids a chance to do what the big kids are doing yet not to the full extent since they will need help. Older children need not complete the last page.

## **Holiday Pages**

There are pages to fill out for each major holiday.
